The Massive Antique Store In Washington That'll Make Your Treasure-Hunting Dreams Come True

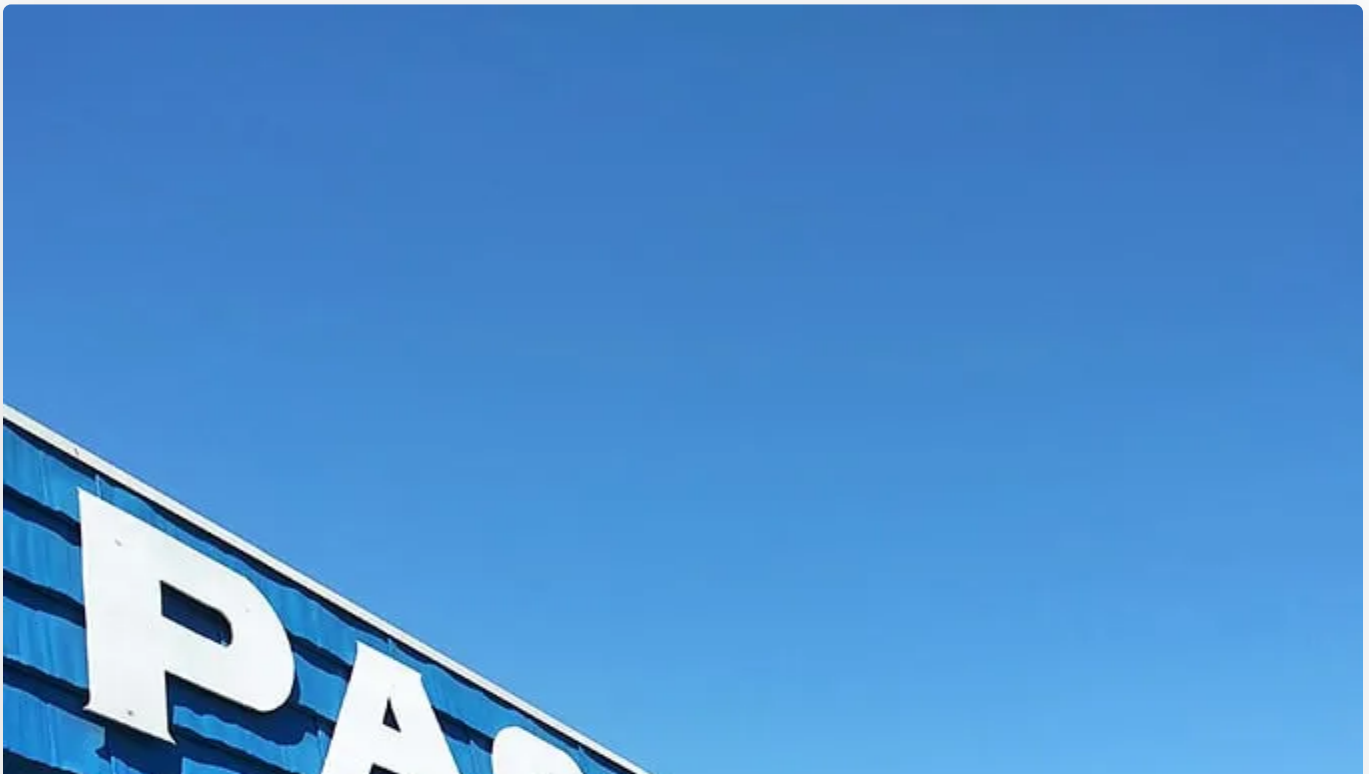

As you approach this unassuming building on *Pacific Ave South* you might

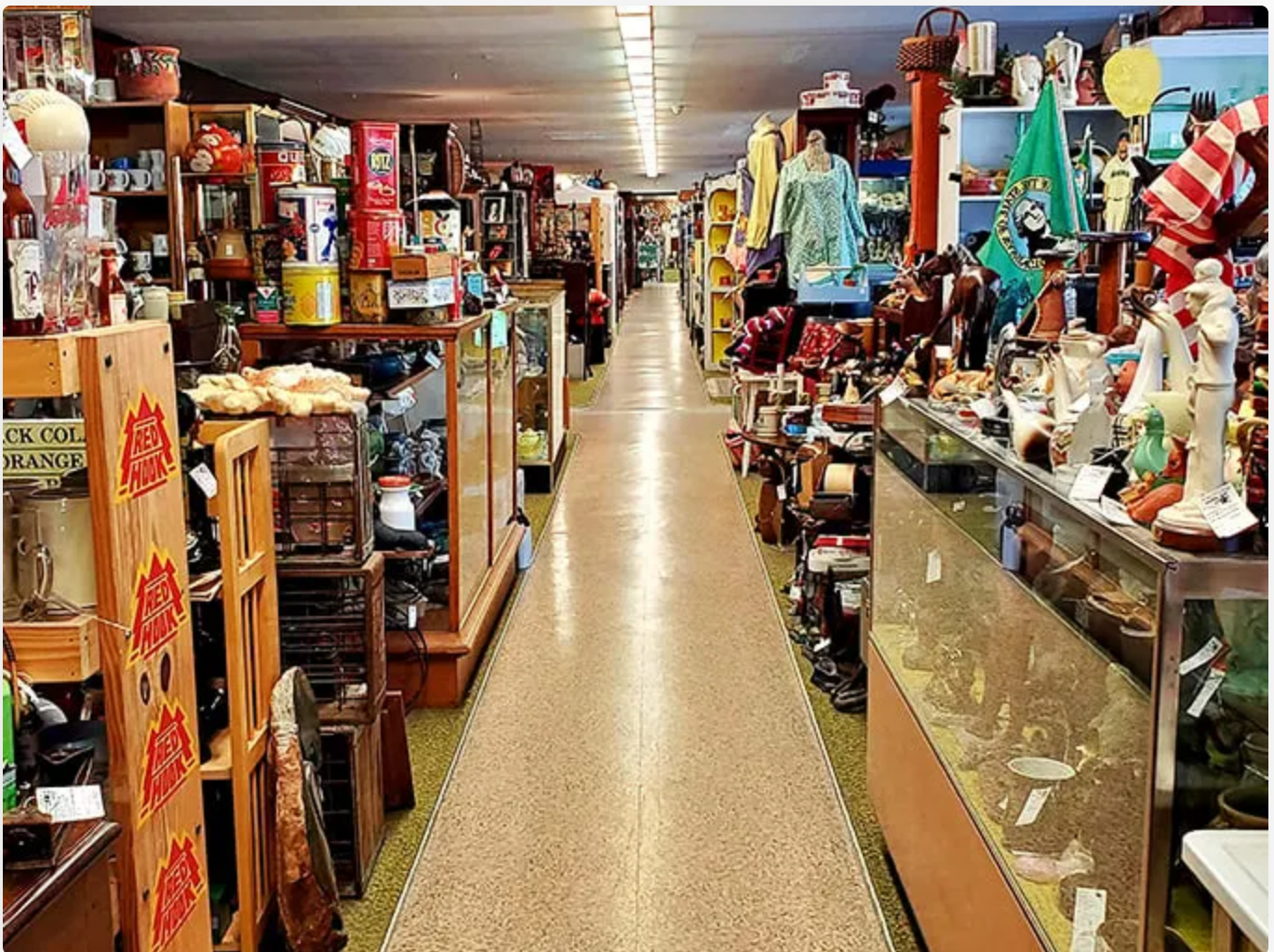
think, “Is this it?”

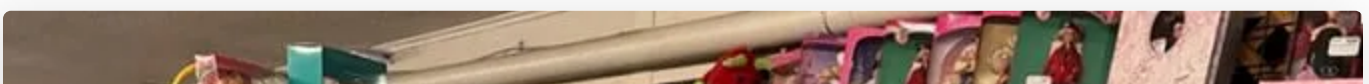
The glassware section is a rainbow of vintage Pyrex, Depression glass, and delicate crystal.

For those who appreciate the art of the written word, there's a delightful selection of vintage stationery, fountain pens, and typewriters.

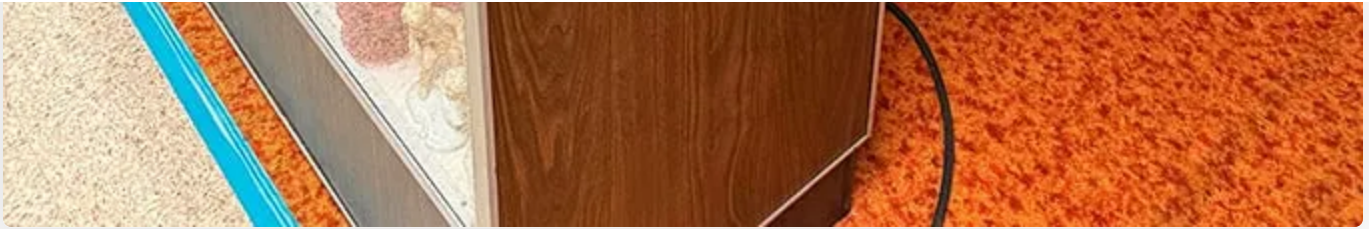
It's enough to make you want to forswear email and return to the days of handwritten letters.

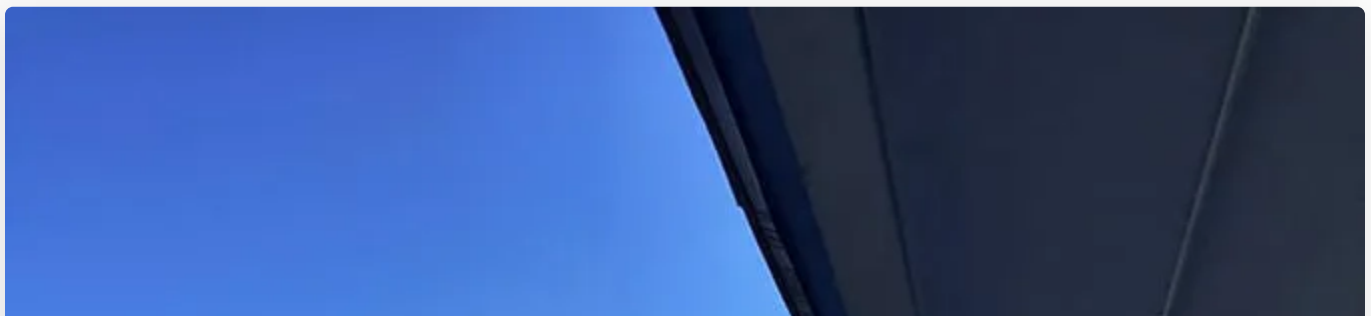

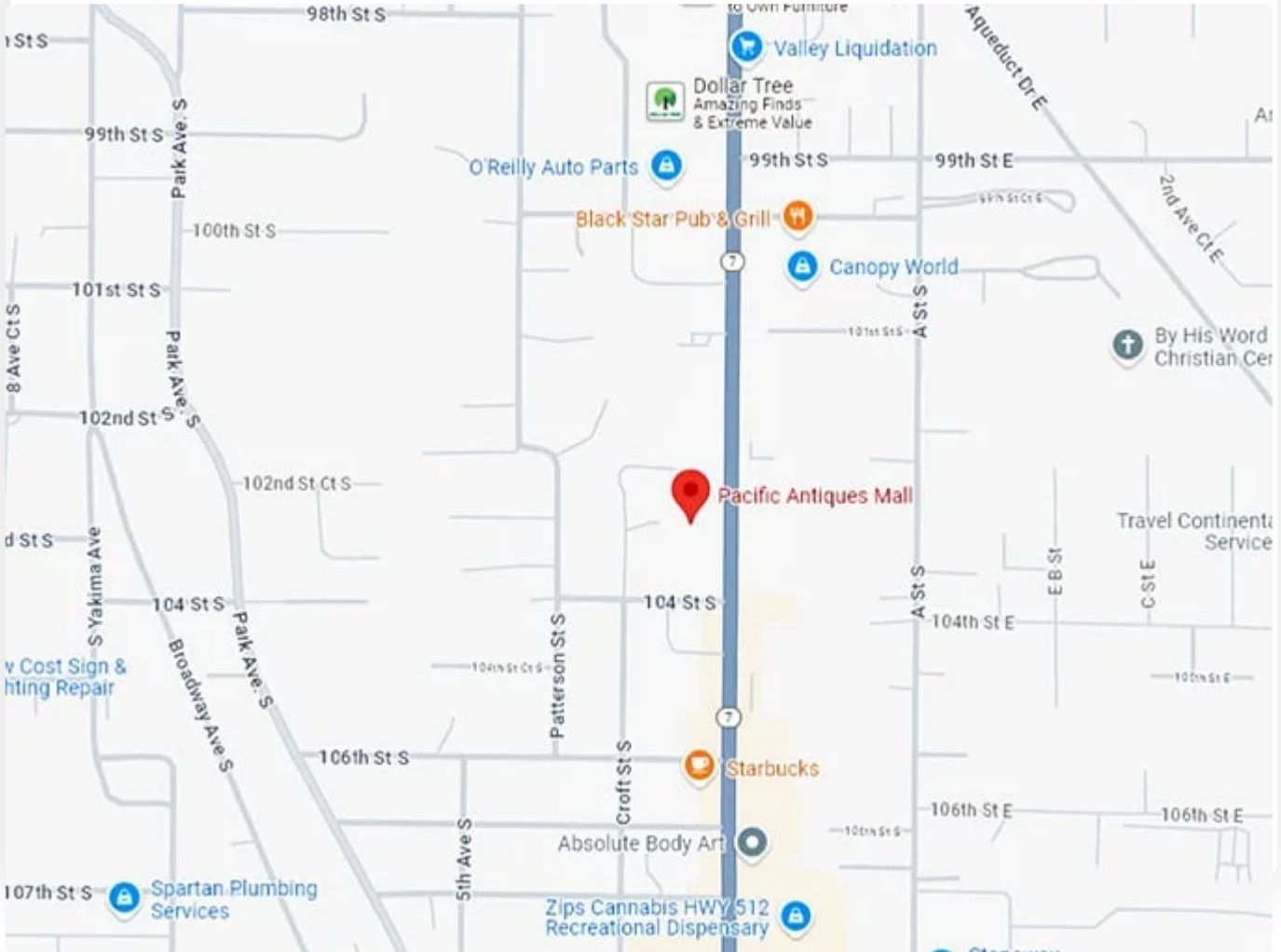
